

□ REGISTER FOR CLASSES

Meet with an advisor for one-on-one academic counseling to register for classes. Make sure to register early to get the classes you want before they fill.

Unless you are given information specific to your high school, registration begins in late March for summer and fall classes and in late October for spring classes. If you are enrolled in a concurrent course taught at your high school campus, your high school will provide you with information regarding required books and supplies.

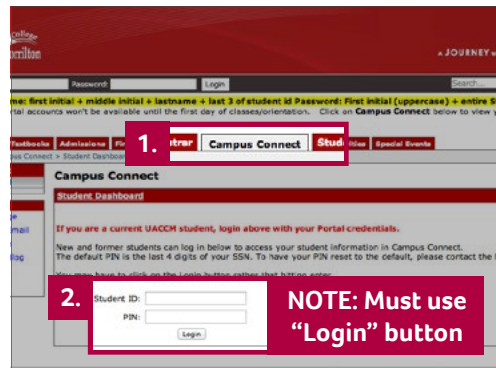
